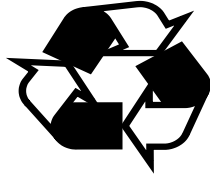

HASBROUCK HEIGHTS RECYCLING AT A GLANCE

Recycle the following...	How to prepare...	Where to take...
Anti Freeze	Save in gallon jugs with label identifying contents	Bergen County's Household Hazardous Waste Days
Appliances	Remove refrigerator/freezer doors	Curbside on Wednesdays/or take to the Recycling Center
Batteries - Lead Acid (Auto)	Keep clean, capped and unbroken	The Recycling Center
Batteries - Alkaline	No longer hazardous waste	Regular trash
Batteries - Rechargeable	Place in separate plastic "baggie" or tape end of terminal	BCUA Household Hazardous Waste Days Or retail location. www.call2recycle.org
Books-Hard Cover	Package with magazines and junk mail tied in bundles	Curbside on Recycling Day, or take to the Recycling Center
Books - Paper Backs	Package with magazines and junk mail	Curbside on Recycling Day, or take to the Recycling Center
Bottles - Glass and Plastic	Rinse clean and co-mingle loose in hard container, <u>NOT IN plastic or paper bags.</u>	Curbside on Recycling Day, or take to the Recycling Center
Brown (Kraft) Paper Bags	Empty, stack, tie. Add to Cardboard.	Curbside on Recycling Day, or take to the Recycling Center
Cans - Steel and Aluminum	Rinse clean and co-mingle loose in hard container. No plastic bags or paper bags.	Curbside on recycling day, or take to the Recycling Center
Cartridges (Laser/Copier/Inkjet)	Package in replacement box with fuser wand	Inkjet Cartridges placed in postage paid mailer, if applies, and dropped in mailbox, or to local office supply store

<u>Plastic Bags (Clean)</u>	<u>Empty, bag together. DO NOT INCLUDE WITH Co-mingled Cans and/or Bottles</u>	<u>Take to Supermarkets who have plastic bag collection containers</u>

Recycle the following...	How to prepare...	Where to take...
Cereal Boxes, Snack Boxes (No soda/beer cartons)	Placed with cardboard. Empty, flatten and tie.	Curbside on recycling day, or the Recycling Center
Clothing (Reusable or New)	Bag manageable quantities	Recycling Center or in bin at shopping centers
Corrugated Cardboard	Empty, flatten and tie. Add brown paper bags.	Curbside on recycling day; or the Recycling Center
E-Waste	Computers (towers, monitors, keyboards, printers) – empty hard drive, secure wiring Televisions – all types Radios, Stereos, Cellular Phones	Curbside on newspaper recycling day -- immediately following newspaper pickup
Glass - Bottles and Jars	Rinse clean and co-mingle loose in hard containers	Curbside on recycling day; or the Recycling Center
Junk Mail	Place with Magazines and Newspaper Inserts. Tied in bundles.	Curbside on recycling day, or the Recycling Center
Magazines	Place with Newspaper Inserts and Junk Mail. Tied in bundles.	Curbside on recycling day, or the Recycling Center
Newspapers	Tied in bundles. No plastic or paper bags.	Curbside on recycling day, or the Recycling Center
Paint Cans - Empty	Empty oil base and latex paint cans placed at curb with lids off as trash	Curbside pickup on garbage/trash day
Paint Cans - Filled	In original containers	B.C. Hazardous Waste Days Not accepted as trash or at Recycling Center
<u>PIZZA BOXES NOT RECYCLABLE</u>	<u>PUT IN TRASH</u>	
Plastic - Bottles and Tubs	Rinse clean and co-mingle loose in hard containers	Curbside on recycling day, or the Recycling Center
Scrap Iron and Metals	Length under six (6) Feet	The Recycling Center
Shredded Paper	Not in Plastic Bags	Place in containers at Borough Hall or to the Recycling Center
Styrofoam Packaging, peanuts, etc. from any appliance or wherever.		Bring to nearby UPS Store
Tires	No Rims	The Recycling Center
Used Motor Oil	Uncontaminated used motor oil in capped Jugs	Recycling Center, Service stations accepting used motor oil or B.C. Household Hazardous Waste Days
Vegetative Waste (Grass, Leaves, Twigs)	See Recycling Calendar	See Recycling Calendar
